## SEAL Off-Campus Trip Policy

# 1. Sign ups/Reminders/Attendance

- a. Trip sign up form will be sent out at least ten business days in advance.
- b. After the bus has a full roster, all remaining signups will be put on a first-come-first-serve waitlist.
- c. A reminder will be sent out five business days in advance
- d. Another reminder will be sent out two business days in advance.
- e. If a student changes their mind about attending, they must notify SEAL 24 hours before the trip.
  - i. Failure to do so will result in a one trip blacklist.

# 2. Day of

- a. Departure from Campus
  - i. SEAL will set a call time of 15 minutes before departure
  - ii. SEAL will call students who have not shown up by the call time.
    - 1. One phone call per student.
  - iii. After all of the current roster has shown up or called, SEAL will start calling the waitlist until the bus is full.
  - iv. The bus will leave on time from Beloit College. If you are not here when the bus leaves, the bus will leave without you.

#### b. While off-campus

- i. SEAL Student Workers will offer their cell phone numbers multiple times.
- ii. If the trip is for a specific event, students MUST go to that specific event.
- iii. Students will notify the SEAL student workers if there are any issues.
- iv. All students must return on the bus there are no exceptions.
- c. Departure from off-campus location
  - SEAL will set a call time of 10 minutes before departure.
    - 1. If s student will be late, they will notify the SEAL workers in advance.
  - ii. If a student is late to the call time without notification, they are blacklisted for the rest of the semester.

### 3. Blacklist Policy

- a. Failure to notify SEAL of your non-attendance will result in ineligibility for the next SEAL trip.
- b. Twice failing to notify SEAL of your non-attendance will result in ineligibility for the rest of the semester.
- All students are to uphold the values and reputation of Beloit College.
  Misbehavior on an off-campus trip is not tolerated, and issues will be brought to the attention of the SEAL Director for assessment.
